Patients of the Mars Hill Medical Center deserve a top-notch facility. Of Hot Springs Health Program's four medical centers, the Mars Hill facility accepts patients the most hours, until 7:00 p.m. seven nights a week. In 2012, the Mars Hill Center had nearly 19,000 patient visits and filled 26,000 prescriptions. Imagine 35 employees currently sharing 6,600 square feet with patients and other visitors!

Key Benefits

- The new facility will house up to 8 physicians (currently 4) and up to 60 (currently 35) professional and support staff, to enable HSHP to meet the demands of a growing community.
- Encompassing 16,700 square feet, the attractive design is all on one level, more than doubling the current floor space.
- The number of exam rooms will increase from 10 to 24.
- The new pharmacy will have convenient, independent accessibility.
- Families with children will have their own child-focused waiting room.
- The plans save money in two ways: 1) the Center will be built on the current site where the parking lot is now, so no new land had to be purchased; and, 2) the existing facility will continue to operate for as long as possible during construction, only minimally interrupting patient care in Mars Hill and averting the need for a costly, temporary location.
